Dear

I am appreciative of the UK government's change in approach and its request for the release from Guantánamo and return to the UK of five former UK residents. I am also very relieved to learn of the recent return of three of these men: Jamil el Banna; Omar Deghayes; and Abdennour Sameur.

I am now writing with regard to Shaker Aamer who continues to be held at Guantánamo.

I understand that he is still detained, and that the Foreign Secretary told Parliament on December 13 that the UK is "no longer in active discussions" with the US concerning Shaker Aamer. I would welcome any information that you can give as to why that is.

Finally, I call on the US government to negotiate with its EU partners to offer safe countries to which detainees can be released in order to facilitate the closure of the Guantánamo Bay detention facility.
